1. Requirements.

The HEGO website is the spearhead of the training methodology and learning. You must have a computer with the following software specifications to be able to use the e-learning platform:

- Web Browser: Internet Explorer 8.0 or newer version (older Internet Explorer should work broadly but without animation). Firefox 10.0 or newer version, Google Chrome 10.0 or newer version, mobile iOS and Android.
- If the user has JavaScript enabled, the “tile” opens with an animated transition.
- Minimum screen resolution: 1024x768.

2. Login

First, the E-learning platform can be change to English (En) language from the top right corner click on the icon of the Global.

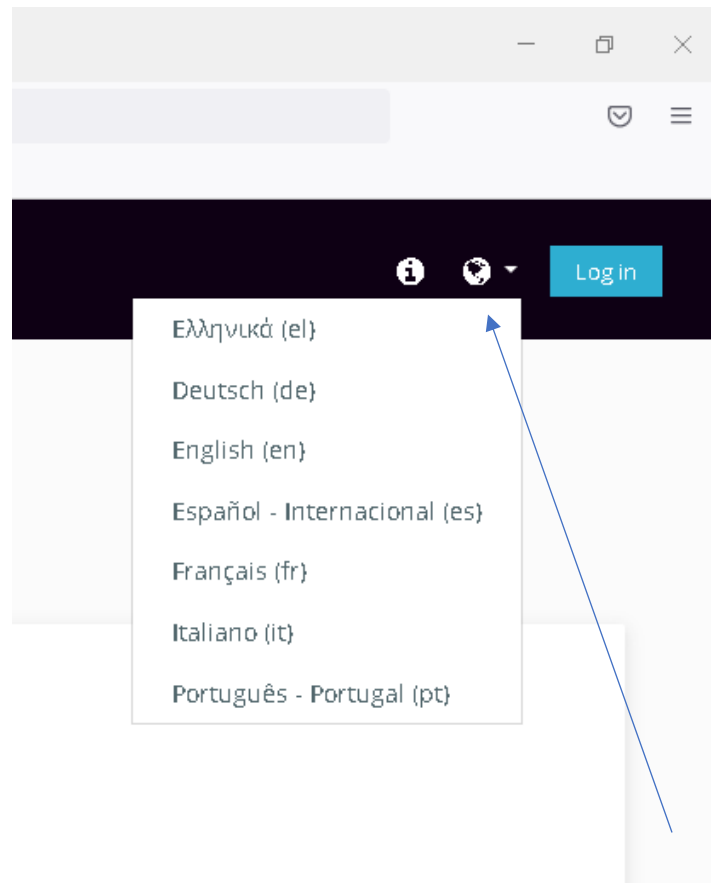


Figure 1 HEGO language icon

The Hego E-learning platform is accessible to registered users. It is possible to browse the platform as a guest, but we recommend logging in as a registered user.

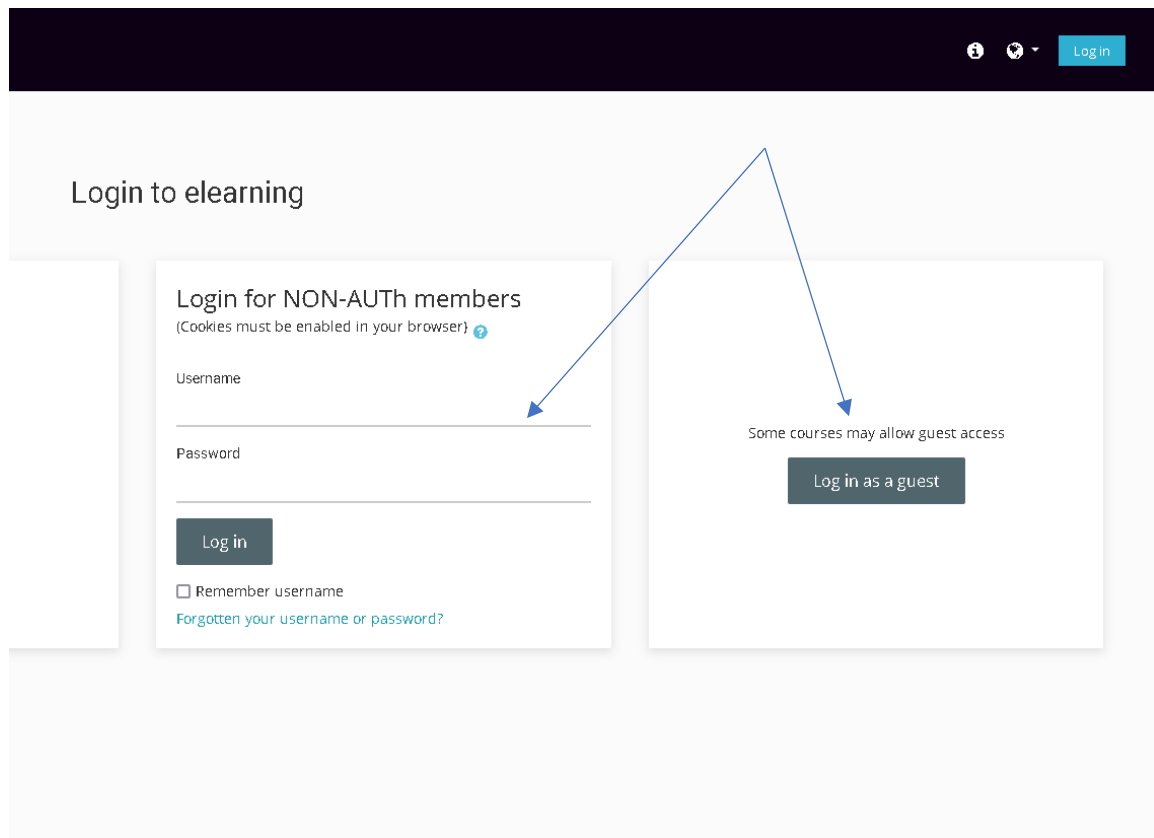


Figure 2 HEGO logon screen

Users must use the security credentials (email address and password) they received from system administrators to access the platform

Upon launching the application, the first screen contains a login form where you must enter your security credentials.

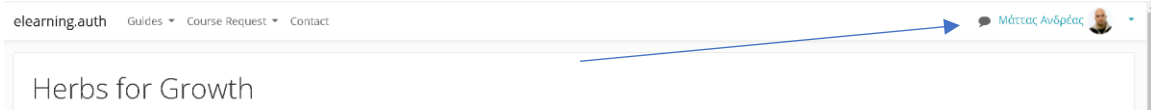


Figure 3 HEGO logo user icon

Log out can be done by selecting it from the drop-down submenu of the top right horizontal menu where your user credential appears.

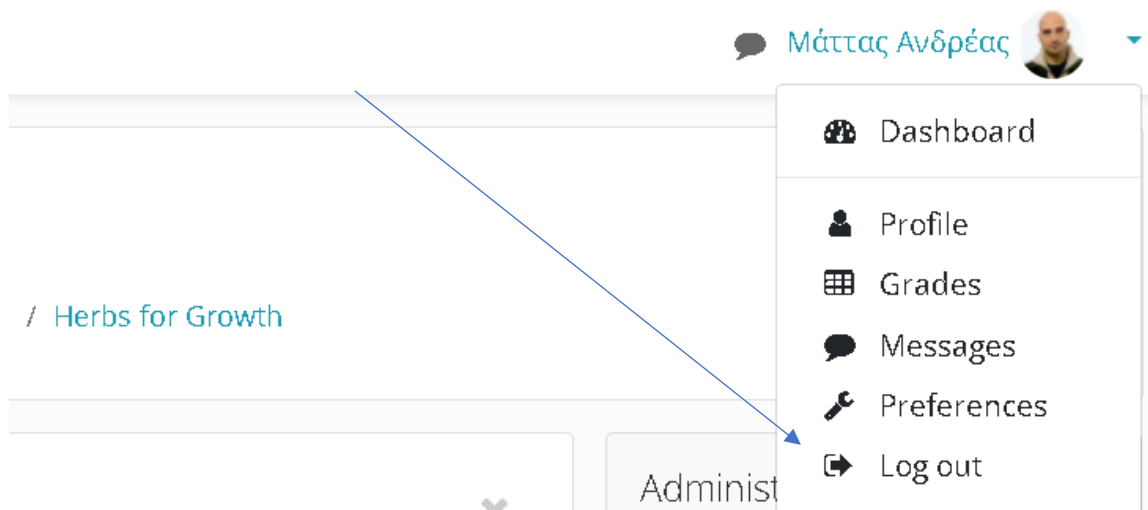


Figure 6 Logout
